of H.P., announced and laid the foundation stone of **Govt. Degree College Gadagusain** on **25th Feb. 2014**. Classes commenced in GSSS Gadagusain from session 2014-15 with **118 students** in B.A.-I (69 boys, 49 girls). They will be remembered forever as the first batch students of this college.

With the help & contribution of the former Chief Minister Hon'ble Jai Ram Thakur Ji, campus construction began in **March 2019** on ~33 Bighas of allotted land surrounding the HHPWD rest house. Presently the college offers **B.A.** (English, Hindi, History, Sociology, Political Science & Music) and **B.Com.** (Fixed conventional course).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. **Prospectus cum Admission Form:** To be purchased from the college office from the college clerk.
2. **Counselling Committee:** First year students to appear before counselling committee to decide about their main/additional and other subjects.
3. **Admission Committee:** Approach with duly filled-in admission form and enclose concerned documents as per the requirement (Matric, +2, SC/ST/OBC/IRDP certificates etc.).
4. **Admission Convener:** Approach the convener for final verification of admission documents.
5. **Principal/Vice Principal:** Approach the Principal/Vice Principal for getting admitted in the college.
6. **Payment of Fee:** Pay prescribed fees within stipulated time period; otherwise admission stands cancelled. Admission is approved after payment of fees only.
7. **Identity Card:** Obtain from the college librarian after showing fee payment receipt within 15 days from the date of admission.
8. **Approval of Identity Card:** After duly filled-in, get it approved/signed and stamped from the dealing clerk/Asstt.
9. **Identity Card signed by Principal:** Approach the Principal for signature on identity card.
10. **Keep Identity Card Safe:** Do not lose your identity card. Duplicate identity card will not be ordinarily issued. Can only be issued after registering FIR and paying cost of new card.
11. **Entry with Identity Card:** Entry inside college campus strictly with identity card only.

Note: As per the direction of the Govt., students shall be admitted only in those subjects for whom teaching staff is available.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION

Eligibility for Admission:

A pass in the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream) conducted by the H.P. Board of School Education (or Prak Shashtri from Sanskrit Colleges affiliated to SPU) or an examination accepted as equivalent thereto by H.P. University.

- Candidates with Science stream get preference in B.Sc./B.C.A.
- Candidates with Commerce stream get preference in B.Com./B.B.A.
- Candidates with Mathematics get preference in B.C.A.

Ordinance 1.4: B.A. 1st Year with Mathematics: either 45% in aggregate or 45 marks in Mathematics at +2 level (5% relaxation for SC/ST).

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM(CBCS)(only for BA/B.Com.2nd & 3rd Year)

Choice based Credit system (CBCS) for UG Classes under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) was introduced in the year 2013, wherein the courses are measured in terms of credits. Further in the year 2016 the new Choice based credit System was introduced in accordance with UGC guidelines. The CBCS provides an opportunity for the students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective or skill based courses. The courses can be evaluated following the grading system, which is considered to be better than the conventional marks system. Therefore, it is necessary to introduce uniform grading system in the entire higher education in India. This will benefit the students to move across institutions within India and across countries. The uniform grading system will also enable potential employers in assessing the performance of the candidates. In order to bring uniformity in evaluation system and computation of the Cumulative Grade point average (CGPA) based on student's performance in the examinations, the UGC has formulated the guidelines to be followed.

1. Discipline Specific Core Course(DSC): A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.

2. Elective Course: A course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/ subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective course.

(i) Discipline Specific Elective Course(DSC)(2 each for regular courses): Elective courses offered under the main discipline /subject of study is referred to as a Discipline Specific Elective.

(ii) Generic Elective Course (GEC):An elective course chosen from an unrelated discipline/subject with an intention to seek exposure to other subjects/disciplines is called a Generic Elective Course.

3. Ability Enhancement Course(AECC):

(I) Ability enhancement Compulsory course (AECC): Environmental Science, English Communication/MIL communication.

(ii) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) Minimum 4: These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands-on / training/field work.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Leave Rules:

- Compulsory to get leave sanctioned before proceeding on leave.
- Medical certificate required for leave exceeding one week.
- Leave up to one week sanctioned by senior tutor. More than one week — apply to Principal.
- Absent 10 consecutive days without information — name struck off from rolls.
- Even on leave, fees must be deposited as per scheduled dates.

Identity Card: Mandatory to carry at all times in college. Must be produced on demand. No duplicate issued if lost.

House Examination: Mandatory to appear in minor tests/House Examination as per calendar — failing which student examination.

General Discipline:

- Maintain best discipline in college campus and outside.
- Any act of indiscipline will be dealt strictly.
- Read notices on student notice board every day.
- Teasing girl students in any manner is a punishable offence under law.
- Writing on blackboards, furniture and walls is indiscipline.
- No meetings/functions/photography without prior permission of Principal.
- Regular attendance required. Absence fine charged from defaulters.

CSCA: College Student's Central Association — elected body (President, VP, General Secretary, Joint Secretary, Class Representatives) plus nominated members on academic merit.

Sports & Cultural Activities: Students participate in all HP University activities. Cultural activities to preserve Seraj area heritage. College CSCA cultural function held annually.

College Magazine (Serajvaani): Student contributions in English, Hindi, Pahari, Commerce and Social Science sections, with staff and student editors.

Career Counselling Cell: Active cell for job awareness, higher study options, and subject selection guidance during admission.

Educational Tours: Visits to places of historical, scientific and cultural importance during vacations.

Parent Teachers Association (PTA): Formed in July/August. Executive body: Chairman, President, VP, Joint Secretary, Treasurer. Mandatory membership Rs. 300/year. Fund used for student welfare.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility (Ordinance 6.2): 75% attendance in each course (theory & practical) is mandatory. Students must obtain in House Examination: (a) 20% marks in each subject, compulsory and elective, OR (b) 25% of the aggregate marks.

Minor/House Tests: Minimum 20% in each subject or 25% in aggregate — required for awarding 45% internal assessment marks and 5% attendance marks.

Re-examination Enrolment: Fee deposited through SBI (or other CBS-enabled banks). Students must online fill examination forms and deposit fee through challan. Keep ID and password secure for future semesters.

RULES REGARDING PAYMENT OF COLLEGE DUES

- Tuition fee charged only from boys for 12 months (June to May) as per schedule.
- Fee and other charges to be paid without fine on dates fixed by the office.
- Fee, fine and other dues once paid shall not be refunded except at discretion of the Principal.
- Names of students who do not pay dues as per schedule will be struck off. Re-admission within 5 days only, on payment of Rs. 100/- plus late fee and fine.
- **Tuition fee exemption:** (i) Girl students, (ii) Among two real brothers one exempted, (iii) Physical disability above 40%.
- **Schedule:** At admission for six months (June-November). Between 20th November to 7th December for December to May.

ZERO TOLERANCE FOR RAGGING as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and Govt. Rajpatra March 25, 2009. Under H.P. Government ordinance of 2009, any student found guilty of ragging will be **imprisoned for up to 3 years** or fined up to **Rs. 50,000/-** or both.

Penalties include:
